This celebrated mechine works beautifully when well oiled and kept in proper repair; it is, however, very slow and remarkably expensive, costing the present proprietor 300,000 patacons a year to maintain, and it of such fragils mechasism that the least thing sets it out of order. Nothing is so distasteful to the general reader as an estay about some
individual, after the manner of Argentine journalists, holding him up as a
most wonderful parties or unequalited
