The River Plate Magazine. The River-Plate Magazine, first number, is at last out, and we are happy to say it is well received.

The magazine contains 64 pages, is well printed and very nicely got up. The first chapter is a biographical sketch of our Admiral Brown, and is really interesting, containing many anecdotes respecting the great Argentine Admiral who was hitherto unknown to our English readers.

The next chapter is a translation from Dominguez's history of the Argentine Confederation. As we so often complain with this work in the text, we have nothing particular to remark, save that its translation into English we regard as extremely useful.

The third chapter, "A Commercial Report of the Trade of the Argentine Republic, to the end of 1859," by our esteemed and talented correspondent, Mr. Greenway, abounds in valuable statistical information.

"Preconceived Opinions," by Mr. P. is the most interesting chapter. Well written, but rather short.

"Music and Musical People," is a well written chapter, and which one would expect to find rather in the "Athletic" or "University Magazine," than in the first number of the "River Plate."

"A Tale of Caracul," from the same pen, discloses the danger of courting a lady in a masked ball. It is a very interesting chapter.

All kinds of wood and iron work are here accomplished in a portable engine, which is a number of hand-cranked wheels, some intricate piece of machinery.

There are three large furnaces, and a steam-hammer, and the noise reminds one of home, for Buenos Ayres cannot boast such a school of industry.
