4th. Once the amount deposited exceeds Twenty five thousand dollars currency or one thousand dollars above the depositor if he wishes can open an account current according to the rates established by the Bank.

5th. In case the depositor loses his Pass Book it can be replaced by another on paying twelve dollars currency, and advertising the loss in the public newspapers.
