Dear Sirs, Yesterday's Standard there appeared another article about the Scotch Church question written by a Glasgow man, in which this gentleman accuses the writer of a former communication of drawing conclusions from an hypothesis which it not possible, &c., &c.

There can be no doubt, however, that tampering with existing institutions and forms merely for a love of change is dangerous and reprehensible, and in matters of religion especially such to be avoided if possible.

There is a sentence or two, however, in 'Glasgowian's' letter to which I would like to call his attention. In one of these 'Glasgowian' enumerates several splendid schemes in connexion with the Church, such as schools, singing classes, &c., and winds up with saying, 'So any one can see that it is not composed of any extremely well.'
