Rio Grande do Sul Railway. Programme of concession made by his Majesty, the Emperor of the Brazils to Robert S. Webb, of the city of New York for the establishment of a line of steamers to run between Rio de Janeiro and New York.

It is conceded to Robert S. Webb, and to his partners or agents to establish a line of steamers between the Brazils and the United States, under the following conditions.

The said R. S. Webb or his agents shall establish a line of monthly steamers between Rio de Janeiro and New York, calling at the ports of Bahia, Pernambuco and Para, as also at such islands in the West Indian Sea and north of Cape Florida in the United States as the concessionaire or his agents may deem fit.

FEARFUL GUNPOWDER EXPLOSION.

Liverpool, Friday, Twelve o'clock. The Loty Sleigh, 120 tons, lying in the Mersey, outward bound for Africa, with a crew of fourteen men, and five tons of gunpowder on board, caught fire - crew taken off - and at 7.30 p.m. the vessel blew up with a fearful report.
